The renovation work restores and celebrates original design and technology concepts of an historic building and seamlessly integrates with a contemporary building.

The Thomas Evans Building and Robert Schattner Center are two of Penn Dental's three facilities. For the flagship Evans Building, BKP demolished 1970s-era offices to capture original 1915 details and ceiling heights and to create open, natural light-filled space. In the Schattner Center, a one-story support area adjacent to the main lobby atrium was modified from a food vendor to space for Student Admissions, Patient Registration, and Patient Billing and Insurance. New casework, finishes, and details were designed to appear as part of the original 2002 aesthetic.
