No detail was overlooked restoring this National Historic Register-listed landmark.

The 1859 Ryerss Mansion overlooks Burholme Park in the Fox Chase neighborhood of Philadelphia. The mansion is home to an eccentric collection of artifacts and antiquities, collected by the Ryerss family and today curated by the Fairmount Park Commission. BKP documented and administered an historically-accurate rehabilitation of the exterior stucco, wood trim, window shutters, balustrade and porch as part of a comprehensive improvements program undertaken by the Fairmount Park Commission in and around Burholme Park.
